WETC classes and presentations are intended only to educate the attendees in a method of researching and utilizing the version of the National Electric Code (NFPA 70) currently adopted by the State of Wisconsin as well as the most recent version of SPS 316, the Wisconsin Electrical Code, to find the correct answers for questions presented on licensing exams. It is the responsibility of the registrant and attendee of WETC sponsored classes to participate in the class and to use the knowledge and skills presented to the best of their abilities. The WETC or the instructors for the classes or events shall not be held liable for exam outcome or result beyond the scope and duration of the class or presentation.

Class Requirements: The WETC reserves the right to limit the maximum number of registrations for any class or event. The WETC also reserves the right to set a minimum number of registrations necessary to conduct the class. Every effort will be made to conduct the class as promoted, however, the WETC will not be liable for changes of time, date, or location that are beyond the control of the WETC other than those stipulations set forth below.

Class Cancellation: The WETC reserves the right to cancel this class for any reason without prior notice. Every effort will be made to notify participants as soon as possible of a cancellation. If payments have been processed at the time of cancellation all funds will be returned to the registrants. However, the WETC will not be liable for travel expenses or motel cancellation penalties incurred by the registrants.

Refund Policy: All registrations will be held until 48 hours prior to the start of the class before processing payments. Checks will not be cashed, and credit cards will not be charged if notification of intent to withdraw from the class is received by 8:00 AM two calendar days prior to the date of the class. If notification of intent to withdraw is received **less than 48 hours prior to the start of the class** the WETC may consider, at their discretion, to: A) Transfer the registration to a future Electrical Exam Prep Class within 12 months of the date of the original class, or B) Refund up to 65% of class fees upon submittal of a completed and signed Refund Request Form. *No-shows, late arrivals, and walk-outs once the class has begun will not be eligible for refunds except in the case of Extenuating Circumstances as defined below.*

Extenuating Circumstances: Should the inability to attend the class arise due to hospitalization or death of an immediate family member, severe sickness, auto accident or other emergent circumstance, the WETC may consider, at their discretion, a full refund of registration fees upon submittal of a completed and signed Refund Request Form.

Refund Request Form: A Refund Request Form will be sent any registrant who notifies our office of the intent to cancel less than 48 hours prior to the start of the class or in the case of Extenuating Circumstances as defined above. The WETC reserves the right to request additional documentation to make an informed decision regarding any requests for refund.
